

PHILOSOPHY AND GOALS

My coaching interest is to develop young athletes in skills, technique, and tactics to help them achieve their personal goals with fencing. I understand that not every fencer is interested in competition, but there will be those who are motivated and have the potential for success with this Olympic sport. Even if a fencer does not have a desire to compete to a large degree, I hope to develop a love for this endeavor that will make fencing a lifelong sport for the individual. At the early ages (youth fencing) where I focus, I feel that my responsibility as a coach is to offer each fencer a solid basis for future success in good technique, to open the eyes of the parents as to the opportunities available as the parents are essential for continued participation, and to continue to work with the youth to develop advanced skills and tactics as they become more competitive.

Athletics is not just about physical fitness but also about learning the value of hard work, practice, focus, concentration, problem solving, and sportsmanship. It helps develop life skills necessary to balance extracurricular activities with other top priorities such as academics and family (and when older a career). Sports can help an individual build a sense of self-confidence. Having spent a year in teaching approximately 100 young physicians as a chief resident, I have a particular interest in learning theory and in methods of teaching highly intelligent and motivated individuals becoming more successful.
